The show is open to any UK born, pedigree registered, Aberdeen Angus cattle. All cattle must be fully registered with the Aberdeen Angus Cattle Society.

Entry fee is £30 (£25 + VAT) per animal. Which must be paid either by Cheque or by BACS to Harrison & Hetherington Ltd

If less than 4 entries forward in any class prize money will be halved.

All cattle must be adequately trained to lead by halter.

Passports must accompany all animals to the show and be handed to the organisers on arrival.

TB – all entries from a one year area must have undergone a pre-movement test within the last 60 days. A copy of the TB test certificate should be available for inspection if required. Animals must be healthy, and free from clinical signs of disease.

Class Bull (Class split once entries close)

Class 1 Yearling Bull Born 1 July to 31 December 2025

Class 2. Bull Calf Classes may be amalgamated or split according to entries

Class 2A – Born 1 January to 28 February 2026

Class 2B – Born 1 March to 31 March 2026

Class 2C – Born 1 April onwards 2026

Class 3. Heifer Class may be split according to entries

Class 4 – Born 1 July to 31 December 2025

Class 4. Heifer Calf Classes may be amalgamated or split according to entries

Class 5A – Born 1 January to 28 February 2026

Class 5B – Born 1 March to 31 March 2026

Class 5C – Born 1 April onwards 2026

Class 6. Pair Of Calves One male and one female already shown in classes 2 & 4
