The show is open to any UK born, pedigree registered, Beef Shorthorn cattle born on or after 1st September 2025. All calves must be fully registered with the Beef Shorthorn Cattle Society and the Exhibitor must be a member of the Beef Shorthorn Cattle Society.

Entry fee is £30 (£25 + VAT) per animal. Which must be paid either by Cheque or by BACS to Harrison & Hetherington Ltd

The Young Handlers classes are free to enter and entries can be accepted on show day. The class will be judged on the handler and NOT the calf. All young handlers will be expected to wear a clean White coat.

Young handlers must have parental permission before entering

Classes will be determined once entries have closed

Rosettes will be awarded to the animals standing 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in each class and a Championship rosette will be awarded to the champion calf.

Prize Money: 1st - £30, 2nd - £20, 3rd - £15, 4th - £10

Champion Calf will be awarded a special rosette, £50 prize money and the Sandwick Perpetual Trophy

Overall Champion Young Handler will receive the Beef shorthorn Young Handler perpetual trophy

All cattle must be adequately trained to lead by halter.

Passports must accompany all animals to the show and be handed to the organisers on arrival.

TB – all entries from a one year area must have undergone a pre-movement test within the last 60 days. A copy of the TB test certificate should be available for inspection if required. Animals must be healthy, and free from clinical signs of disease.
