All calves must be fully registered with the Hereford Cattle Society and the Exhibitor must be a member of the Hereford Cattle Society.

Entry fee is £30 (£25 + VAT) per animal. Which must be paid either by Cheque or by BACS to Harrison & Hetherington Ltd

The Young Handlers classes are judged after the main show. They are free to enter and entries can be accepted on show day.

All cattle must be adequately trained to lead by halter. All bulls 12 months and over must have a permanent nose ring. There are no facilities to accommodate Dams of calves

Passports must accompany all animals to the show and be handed to the organisers on arrival.

TB – all entries from a one year area must have undergone a pre-movement test within the last 60 days. A copy of the TB test certificate should be available for inspection if required. Animals must be healthy, and free from clinical signs of disease.
