The Show

The show is open to all UK born Pedigree Registered Beef Shorthorn calves born on or after 1st September 2021.

Rosettes will be awarded to the animals standing 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th in each class and a championship rosette will be awarded to the champion calf.

Classes may be split depending on the number of entries.

Classes

The Classes will be split after entries close according to the number and age of calves entered. All fully registered calves born on or after 1st September 2021 are eligible for entry.

There will be 2 classes for young handlers as follows:

Young Handler	Aged 16 and under (on the day of the show)
Young Handler	Aged 17 to 21 (on the day of the show)

All calves must be fully registered with the Beef Shorthorn Cattle Society and the exhibitor must be a member of the Beef Shorthorn Cattle Society.

Entry Fee

An entry form must be completed to enter in the calf show and an entry fee of **£20 + VAT (£24) per calf** paid to Harrison & Hetherington must be submitted via BACS or with the entry form and returned to: -

There is no entry fee for Young Handlers Classes and entries for these classes will be taken on the day. It is the handlers and NOT the calves which will be judged. All young handlers will be expected to wear clean white coats.

Cattle to be penned on: **Thursday, 27th October 2022**

Please note a limited amount of straw will be provided.

Any further requirements must be brought by the exhibitor.

All cattle must be adequately trained to lead by halter.

Passports must accompany all animals to the show and be handed to the organisers on arrival.

The show is open to all members of the Beef Shorthorn Cattle Society.

Unregistered animals will not be accepted for the show.

Overall Champion Calf

The Champion Calf will be awarded a special rosette with £50 prize money.

Overall Champion Young Handler

The Champion Young Handler will receive the Beef Shorthorn Young Handlers perpetual trophy
